2. Project Overview

Careys Civil Engineering have been appointed by Caudwell Properties (109) Ltd to deliver the Groundworks and Reinforced Concrete elements of the Audley Square Development.

The works commenced in July 2020, with completion scheduled for March 2023.

Remaining Scheme Overview:

- a) Bulk Excavation for 5 levels of basement (Top Down and Blue-Sky zones)
- b) Waterproofing system installation to basement
- c) Drainage installation throughout building
- d) Construction of Reinforced Concrete basement and superstructure elements






4. Key Project Timeline























5. Recent Activities

- Ground Source Heat Pump (GSHP) borehole mini piles ongoing until end of June.
- Careys are continuing with pile mat excavation across the site from the west elevation towards the
 east of site.
- Concrete guidewall removal is ongoing around the perimeter of site.
- Ground Floor Slab construction has started to the west of site in zone 1.
- Vehicles are continuing to access through Gate 2 and Gate 3 on Waverton Street.






General Overview – Pile Cropping & Excavation






Commencement of GF Slab Construction to West Elevation of Site






Preparation For Slab Construction














- Careys will continue with the pilemat excavation and guidewall removal across the site. The team are working from the west elevation of site in Zone 1 and making their way across site towards Zone 2 in the east.
- The construction of the new Garden/ Ground Level Slab has commence to the west elevation of site and progress will be from west to east.
- Ongoing GSHP boring works will continue until end of June/July



7. BPM Improvements & Innovations

- Site continue to use water suppression throughout the day dampen down potential dust onsite along vehicle routes and stockpiles.
- Careys are using hydraulic excavator mounted "Pile Croppers" to cut the new piles down to the design level during the slab construction. The cropping method produces little noise compared to traditional breaking methods. See below photo showing cropper in practice.
- Careys are using a hydraulic excavator mounted cutting jaw to chew up concrete where possible instead of traditional pin breaking. This method reduces noise output around the site.










BPM Improvements & Innovations

• As well as local acoustic screens around smaller plant, acoustic screens have also been installed along the full length of Waverton Street, as well as partial coverage on South Audley Street and will remain in place during the excavation phase.







8. TC1 Tower Crane Erection – 31st July








TC1 is provisionally booked to be erected on the weekend of 31st July. There will be no road closures required for this activity, it will take place from within site boundary.



Vehicle Routes










