2. Project Overview

Careys Civil Engineering have been appointed by Caudwell Properties (109) Ltd to deliver the Groundworks and Reinforced Concrete elements of the Audley Square Development.

The works commenced in July 2020, with completion scheduled for March 2023.

Remaining Scheme Overview:

- Bulk Excavation for 5 levels of basement (Top Down and Blue-Sky zones) a)
- Waterproofing system installation to basement b)
- Drainage installation throughout building C)
- Construction of Reinforced Concrete basement and superstructure elements d)










Stage 7 B5 Raft formation Top-down excavation continued








Stage 8 Jumpform launched. Top-down excavation continued









5. Recent Activities

- Careys completed pile mat excavation in Zone 1 to West of site.
- The site team continued with pile mat excavation in Zone 2 to the East of the site.
- Ground Source Heat Pump (GSHP) boreholes ongoing until end of July.
- Concrete guidewall removal was completed across the site.
- Ground Floor Slab construction continues to the west of site in zone 1 with reinforcement and drainage installation ongoing.
- Vehicles are continuing to access through Gate 2 on Waverton Street.










6. Upcoming Activities (This Month)

- Careys will complete the pile mat excavation in Zone 2 to East of site.
- The construction of the new Garden/ Ground Level Slab will continue across the site from west to east.
- Reinforcement fixing and concrete delivery will continue in Zone 1 to the West of site.
- Ongoing GSHP boring works will continue until end of July.
- Careys and Caudwell Properties will be hosting a charity softball tournament on 5th August to raise money for Caudwell Children.









7. Garden / Ground Level Slab Construction

The image below shows the completed new Garden/Ground Level concrete slab. This is the current stage of construction.

The casting of the concrete will be split up into individual pours as indicated by the blue lines below.

Each pour will take place on a different day. The size of each pour has been determined based on achievable supply of concrete on any given day. These slabs will be cast by circa September 2021. Once the slab is complete, it will provide a vehicle traffic slab across the site.


8. BPM Improvements & Innovations

- Site continue to use water suppression throughout the day dampen down potential dust onsite along vehicle routes and stockpiles.
- Careys are using hydraulic excavator mounted "Pile Croppers" to cut the new piles down to the design level during the slab construction. The cropping method produces little noise compared to traditional breaking methods. See below photo showing cropper in practice. These will be used throughout the basement excavation also.
- Careys are using a hydraulic excavator mounted cutting jaw to chew up concrete where possible instead of traditional pin breaking. This method reduces noise output around the site and will be used for removing concrete during bulk basement excavation also.








• As well as local acoustic screens around smaller plant, acoustic screens have also been installed along the full length of Waverton Street, as well as partial coverage on South Audley Street and will remain in place during the excavation phase.








9. TC1 Tower Crane Erection – 14th/15th August










Vehicle Routes

Through an exciting partnership with national children's charity, Caudwell Children, we aim to raise a total of $\pounds1$ million to help support disabled children and their families living in the UK.


Through employee fundraising activities, corporate sponsorship and community engagement the project team will deliver on our ambitious target and in doing so fund vital support for disadvantaged children.
