# 2. Project Overview

Careys Civil Engineering have been appointed by Caudwell Properties (109) Ltd to deliver the Groundworks and Reinforced Concrete elements of the Audley Square Development.

The works commenced in July 2020, with completion scheduled for March 2023.

Remaining Scheme Overview:

- a) Bulk Excavation for 5 levels of basement (Top Down and Blue-Sky zones)
- b) Waterproofing system installation to basement
- c) Drainage installation throughout building
- d) Construction of Reinforced Concrete basement and superstructure elements





# 4. Key Project Timeline
























### 5. Recent Activities

- Ground Floor Slab construction continued to the west of site in zone 1 as well as zone 2 in the east with reinforcement and drainage installation ongoing. 5 sections of the Ground Floor slab were cast during the month of August.
- Steel fixing for slab construction was ongoing along Red Lion Yard elevation as well as Waverton Street.
- All site vehicles are continuing to access through Gate 2 on Waverton Street.








Typical plan view of steel fixing ongoing for slab construction beside the South Audley Street / Nehru Centre elevation








Example of Completed Slabs cast along South Audley Street Elevation














Commencement of Pour 1 G0 Slab along 51 Hill Street Elevation





Pour 7 G0 Slab ready to cast along Rey Lion Yard Elevation






Pour 7 G0 Slab along RLY – Completed 14/09/21 (Today)





- Careys will complete the groundworks in Zone 2 to East of site in preparation for steel fixing and slab construction.
- The construction of the new Garden/ Ground Level Slab will continue across the site from west to east. The slab pours have been divided up into individual manageable sizes.
- Reinforcement fixing and concrete delivery will continue in Zone 2 to the East of site via gate 2 on Waverton Street.
- Gate 2 will be closed for a number of weeks when the site team are constructing the slab directly behind it. During this period, all site delivery vehicles will access and egress site via Gate 3 on Waverton Street.









# 8. BPM Improvements & Innovations



• Site continue to use water suppression throughout the day to dampen down potential dust onsite along vehicle routes and stockpiles.










### BPM Improvements & Innovations

- As well as local acoustic screens around smaller plant, acoustic screens have also been installed along the full length of Waverton Street where possible, as well as partial coverage on South Audley Street and will remain in place during the excavation phase.
- Although the noise barriers are not currently required on the perimeter hoarding for the current and less noisy works over the next 2 months, the site team left them in place as added additional protection during this period.














- Careys are using hydraulic excavator mounted "Pile Croppers" to cut the new piles down to the design level during the slab construction. The cropping method produces little noise compared to traditional breaking methods. See below photo showing cropper in practice. Although not currently being used at the moment, these will be used throughout the basement excavation phase.
- Careys are using a hydraulic excavator mounted cutting jaw to chew up concrete where possible instead of traditional pin breaking. This method reduces noise output around the site and will be used for removing concrete walls where required during bulk basement excavation phase.







#### 9. TC2 Tower Crane Erection – November 2021






TC2 is booked to be erected on the weekend of 6/7<sup>th</sup> November. A temporary road closure will be required on Hill Street over certain periods of the weekend.


